Thank you for registering your class to attend the Youth Environmental Summit (YES), taking place online from Monday, April 19 through Friday, April 23. Below, please frequently asked questions. Should you have any questions, please call (714) 378-3257 or email ocyouthsummit@ocwd.com.

When may I access the YES website?

You may log in any time after 7:45 a.m. on Monday, April 19. The event officially “begins” at 8:45 a.m. All Monday content will be on demand. Live presentations begin Tuesday.

After launch, teachers and students may access the website at any time throughout the week. However, the Help Bot and Classroom portion of the site will only be available from 7:45 a.m. through 4 p.m. each day.

My class doesn't use Zoom. Can I still participate?

Yes. Zoom is only used in the Classroom portion of the website, and a Zoom account and log in is not required. User who enter this space will automatically be connected to their Zoom room based upon the login credentials used to access the event website. To access this space, click the Classroom tab at the top of the website. Once inside, hover over the picture and your name will appear (example: Teacher Smith's Classroom.) Click this picture to be taken to the Zoom room.

Using this section of the website is not required. You may access all areas of the website simply by logging in.

I will have a substitute during the week of YES. Can they access the event website?

Yes. Simply share your login info with your substitute.

Is there time for Q&A during the live presentations?

Yes. The last 10-15 minutes of each live presentation will be dedicated to Q&A. Please submit your questions in the Q&A box. The Q&A is moderated so we will not see questions submitted, but rest assured we have received your response. Speakers will try to answer as many questions as possible but due to the number of students and limited time, may not get to everyone. We apologize in advance if we do not get to your question.

Are additional materials required?

Yes and no. Many of our presenters have included activities designed to be completed during or after their video. You and your students are encouraged to print and complete these activities. In addition, some post-activities involve experiments that can be done at home. Presenters tried their best to include lists of easy to acquire ingredients. None of these actions are required to enjoy YES. They are merely there as an additional option to expand learning and engagement.

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
